We very much look forward to seeing you in a few days at the ALEA annual meeting at the University of Chicago! Here is some logistical information about the meeting.

**Location:** All program sessions, meals, and social functions will be held in the David Rubenstein Forum, located at 1201 E. 60th St., Chicago IL. Front desk personnel will direct you to registration, which is on the 2nd Floor. The conference will begin with a continental breakfast each morning from 8:00 – 9:00 a.m. and sessions will begin at 9:00 a.m.. All conference meals will be held in Room A/B on the 2nd Floor of the Rubenstein Forum.

**Parking:** The closest parking garage is Kimbark South, located less than a block from the Forum at 6021 S. Kimbark Ave. Parking is free all along the Midway Plaisance if you can find a spot. You can also park for free in the Law School lot after 4 pm on Friday and anytime Saturday (enter from S. University Ave., south of 60th Street). See the map attached to this email.

**Shuttle:** At the conclusion of Friday's dinner, Windy City Shuttle will make one run from the Rubenstein Forum to The Sophy and Hyatt Place, both located on 53rd Street in Hyde Park.
